## COMMUNICATION RESOURCES AND TIMELINE

Our common goal is to ensure the survey gets as many respondents as possible. Participating institutions are therefore encouraged to start communicating on their involvement in the project as early as possible. Without minimal communication activities, there is risk of a very low engagement in the survey.

We are providing indicative messages and timeline for your communication activities, covering the main points; feel free to adapt it to your institution. We suggest that you add any relevant information specific to your institution in relation to the topic, i.e., internal policy, events etc.
